Blowzabella is a genuinely unique band that makes an inimitable, driving, drone-based sound played with a fabulous sense of melody, rhythmic expertise and sheer feeling. They compose their own music influenced by English and European traditional folk music and song. All the band members compose and many of their tunes are 'standards' in the modern British/European folk repertoire and played by people all over the world. Much loved and respected, there is no one else quite like them. **Blowzabella** are Andy Cutting on diatonic button accordion, Jo Freya on vocals, saxophone and clarinet, Paul James on vocals, bagpipes and saxophones, Gregory Jolivet on hurdy-gurdy, David Shepherd on violin, Barn Stradling on bass guitar and Jon Swayne on bagpipes and saxophone.

JESS GILLAM & FRIENDS

The first saxophonist to make it to the final of BBC Young Musician finalist Jess Gillam is a persuasive advocate for her instrument's contemporary classical credentials, and a versatile performer in any genre. For her St David's Hall debut she's joined by her podcasting companion, pianist Zeynep Ozcusa and bassist Andee Price for an eclectic programme that ranges from Michael Nyman, Chick Corea, George Gershwin and David Bowie. The programme will also feature a new Tŷ Cerdd commission from a Welsh composer.

GWYNETH GLYN & FRIENDS

Writer, poet and musician **Gwyneth Glyn** presents her new album *Tro* with band members Rowan Rheingans, Dylan Fowler and Gillian Stevens. *Tro*, which is Welsh for 'turn', is the first major solo album from one of Wales' most intriguing and talented artists, who applies her delicate craft and exquisite gift to this compelling new work. Her global influences are subtly felt throughout the layers of this bold album, exploring where Wales meets the world with the beautiful nuances and gorgeous tones of Gwyneth's voice which work seamlessly in both Welsh and English. Gwyneth received a nomination for Best Original Track at the BBC Radio 2 Folk Award earlier this year for the track *Cân Y Cŵn* which features on *Tro*.

Enqebwyd Gwyneth am y Trac Gwreiddiol Gorau yng Ngwobrau Gwerin BBC Radio 2 yn gynharach eleni am y trac Cân Y Cŵn sydd ar Tro.

MARTIN CARTHY & JOHN KIRKPATRICK

National treasures Martin Carthy & John Kirkpatrick embark on a rare UK duo tour. These two leading interpreters of English folk traditions – folk guitarist and singer Carthy and squeezebox virtuoso and singer Kirkpatrick – are long-time collaborators in a variety of seminal musical projects: from John's iconic 1976 Morris tunes album *Plain Capers* through *Steeleye Span* to *Brass Monkey*. Their enduring enjoyment of playing with each other shines through in their performances making them warm, natural, charismatic and eminently enjoyable. Pure English folk pedigree!
